On the morning of October 5, the third and fourth grade classroom was transformed into a place called "The 4 Fishy Friends' Store," which allowed the students to sharpen their math skills with making change. Fourth grade completed their challenging lessons on making change in class, and third grade remembered quite a bit about it from last year. So the kids agreed that the best way to practice this skill would be to set up a store in the classroom, and that's exactly what they did!

First, the kids spent an afternoon making different items to sell. Erin Kilby made creative do-it-yourself room decoration kits. Ben Kelsey helped make awesome beaded necklace kits, and Zachary Shipe and Jack Spencer constructed some great wooden spoon puppets. Other items that sold in the store were paper star pins, fancy feather pencils, erasers, lollipops, bookmarks, and stickers. In the end, the students were very pleased with the selection of items to be sold and super excited to get the store open the next day.

On the following day, they set up the store. The kids rearranged the desks and tables so that each student had a separate place to put his or her homemade items and the money to be used for change. The students explained to me what the cheapest and most expensive items were, and everything in the store ended up being priced from 25 cents to \$1.00.

Students made their price signs, arranged their spot so that it looked attractive, and patiently waited for their customers.

From 10:30 to 11:30 that morning, our friends in junior kindergarten through second grade got to shop at "The 4 Fishy Friends' Store." Each customer received a pretend five dollar bill in a brown paper bag. The children were allowed to spend the money on whatever they chose. Many customers chose one of everything, but some tended to choose fewer expensive items and more lollipops. The customers were very happy with their products, and there was something there for everyone.

Overall, the store was a huge success! Not only did third and fourth grade do very well with making change, but they also did an excellent job making their products. Furthermore, the customer service was superb.

Mrs. Mitchell and Mrs. Tasker have both said their students keep asking when they can visit the store again, and third and fourth grade are already thinking about what they are going to sell when "The 4 Fishy Friends' Store" opens for business again!
